- a. Each local conference or local mission/field shall be entitled to one delegate without regard to conference or mission/field membership and one additional delegate for each one thousand two hundred (1200) church members or major fraction thereof.*

DELEGATES AT LARGE

Article VIII, Sec. 2. Delegates at large

Delegates at large to a union mission constituency meeting include:

- a. The current members of the executive committee of this union mission.***
- b. Such other persons from the union mission staff, institutions owned and operated by the union, institutions operated by the division and located within the union territory, and local conferences or local missions/fields, as may be recommended by the union mission executive committee and accepted by the delegates in the constituency meeting. The number of such delegates shall not exceed ten percent (10%) of the total number of regular delegates provided for hereinabove.***
- c. Members of the General Conference and Inter-American Division executive committees who may be present at any constituency meeting of this union mission. The number of such delegates shall not exceed ten percent (10%) of the total number of delegates otherwise provided for.***

SESSION COMMITTEES

ORGANIZING COMMITTEE

Article IX, Sec. 1. Organizing Committee

- a. An Organizing Committee shall be appointed for each constituent meeting. It shall consist of three (3) representatives from each local conference or local mission/field, and one (1) additional representative from each local field with more than ten thousand (10,000) members, a representative from every institution operated by the union or institution operated by the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists-Inter-American Division in the territory of this union, in addition to the president of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists-Inter-American Division, or the person designated by him, who will preside over the meeting and who will have the right to vote. The administrators of the General Conference and the Inter-American Division or their representatives who are present will be invited to attend the organizing committee as advisors.**
- b. The members of the organizing committee shall be appointed by their respective delegates as one of the first items of business at each regularly scheduled constituency meeting.**
- c. The organizing committee shall nominate, and the constituency shall elect:**
 - 1) A nominating committee.**
 - 2) The chairman and secretary of the Plans and Recommendations Committee.**
 - 3) Other committees as may be necessary.**

NOMINATING COMMITTEE

Article IX, Sec. 2. Nominating Committee:

The Nominating Committee shall consist of one representative from each conference or mission with no regard for its membership, and one additional delegate for each two thousand (2000) church members based on the December 31 membership of the previous year, and the highest-ranking member of each institution of the union mission. The administrators of the General Conference and Inter-American Division or their representatives who are present will be invited to attend the nominating committee as advisors.

The president of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists - Inter-American Division or his designee shall serve as chairman of the Nominating Committee during the quinquennial session of the union mission and will have the right to vote.

Article VII, Sec. 11. Elections/Appointments and Term of Office:

a. Elections:

The union constituency meeting shall also elect the members (other than ex officio) of the union executive committee and, where required by the governance documents of union institutions, the chief administrator(s) and board members of such entities.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBERS

Article X, Sec. 1. Membership of Executive Committee:

The executive committee of the Atlantic Caribbean Union Mission of Seventh-day Adventists shall be elected in their regular session and will consist of: the president, the secretary, and treasurer of the union, the president, the secretary, and treasurer of local missions and conferences, the directors of the union institutions, the departmental directors of the union, an appointive member from each conference, mission, or institution of the union, fifteen percent of the number detailed above will comprise of persons not employed by the church, and who will be appointed at the constituency meeting of the union. The officers of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists and the officers of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists-Inter-American Division are members ex officio of the union mission executive committee; however, their membership shall be in addition to the number detailed above. Any such officers exercising their voting rights at any one meeting shall not make up more than ten percent of the committee membership present.
